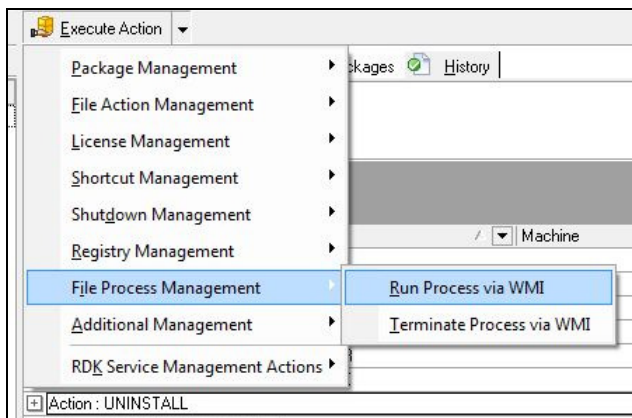




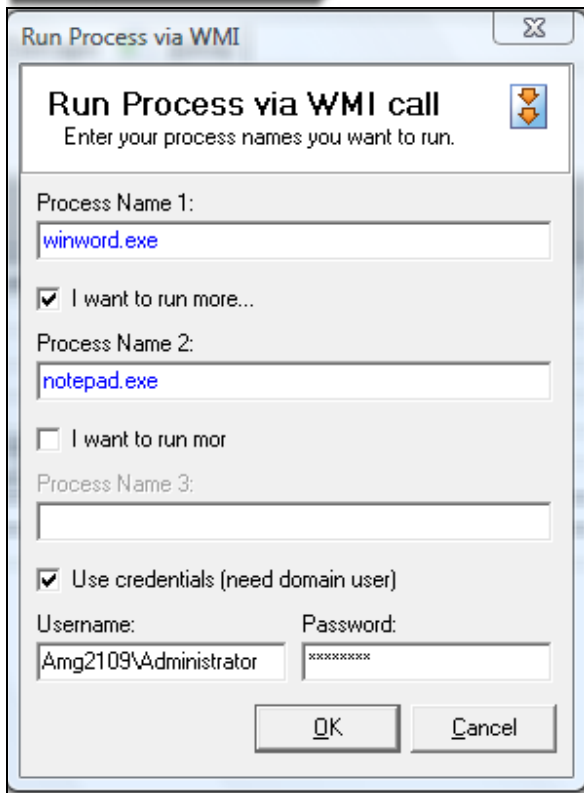
How to Terminate a Process using WMI on Network Computers

The steps below will instruct you how to create up to three processes to terminate applications on the networked computers. You can specify to use another's credentials if the login does not have administrative privileges to complete the task by entering the username and password into the Terminate Process window.

1. Choose **Execute Action > File Process Management > Terminate Process via WMI**.



2. Enter the command that you want to terminate.
3. If you wish to terminate more than one process, place a checkmark in the *I want to terminate more....* box(es).
4. Place a checkmark in the *Use Credentials* window if you want to run the process as a particular user.
5. Enter a Username and Password if applicable.



6. Click **Ok**.
